Resolution 2013-11 A resolution rescinding Resolution 2005-11

Whereas, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution 2005-11, establishing regulations for conducting controlled burns in Lincoln County, Kansas.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners rescinds Resolution 2005-11 and enacts the following Rules on Controlled Burns:

- 1. Notify the Lincoln County Sheriff at 785-524-4479 Giving name, exact location of burns, when the fire will be set, when the fire is secure, and contact phone number.
- 2. Weather
 - a. Wind speeds 5 to 15 miles per hour as forecasted by NOAA
- 3. Adequate Fire Break.
- 4. Equipment on Hand
 - a. Tractor and Disc or other extinguishing equipment
 - b. Adequate portable water supply
- 5. Constant Adult Supervision at the Controlled Burn Site
- 6. Recommend that a fire plan be developed with NRCS when burning CRP and range land
- 7. Ensure that smoke from controlled burn will not become a traffic hazard

Out of Control Burns: If the guidelines are not followed, the person will pay a penalty for the fire run, as follows

- a. \$250.00 per truck that responds to help fight the fire
- b. \$5.00 per hour for each fireman that responds.

Now, Therefore Be it Further Resolved, that at any time there is more than one agency responding to any fire call, that a temporary burn ban will become in effect until the fire is under control and supporting agencies have been dismissed from the scene.
