COVID 19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of March, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of LINCOLN County, Kansas declared there was a state of local public health emergency in LINCOLN County, Kansas resulting in potential or occurring Pandemic known as COVID 19, in LINCOLN County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, such conditions endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of LINCOLN County, Kansas.

WHEREAS, That the state of local public health emergency in Lincoln County, Kansas declared on the 17th day of March, 2020, was to remain in effect for 60 days unless terminated earlier.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of LINCOLN County, Kansas:

That the state of local public health emergency in Lincoln County, Kansas declared on the 17th day of March, 2020, needs to be extend and shall continue and remain in effect for an additional 60 days unless terminated earlier.

That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to LINCOLN County, Kansas and shall initiate the rendering of aid and assistance there under.

That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law for 60 days unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.
