

FINAL RESOLUTION AND ORDER  
RESOLUTION NO. 2013V-02

Now on this 24th day of June 2013, at a duly constituted and regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, Lincoln County, Kansas, all members of said board being present, the matter of the vacation of a certain road comes on for final hearing and order before said board.

After due consideration, and after being duly advised in the premises, the board finds, that on the 10th day of June, 2013, the said board did unanimously make a preliminary resolution, Resolution 2013R-02, proposing to vacate certain street and alley, as in their judgement said street and alley is not a public utility by reason of neglect, nonuse, or inconvenience or from other cause or causes said street and alley has become practically impassable and the necessity for said street and alley as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said street and alley or put the same in condition for public travel; said street and alley described as follows:

That part of Vesper Ave lying North of Lot 1 and 14, Block 2 of Vesper City, Right of way being 70 ft.

An undeveloped alley beginning 70' North of the Northwest corner of lot 12 Block 1, Vesper City thence east 132 ft to the alley. Said alley being 8' wide from West to East and 132 ft wide from North to South.


and that said preliminary resolution is herewith adopted and made a part of this order by reference.

The board further finds that due and legal notice of said proposed vacation has been given by publication as required by law, and the proof thereof has been duly filed with the County Clerk.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ALL MEMBERS VOTING IN THE AFFIRMATIVE: That the above described road, and every part hereof, should be vacated, and it is hereby vacated, as above described, and that the County Clerk enter the proceedings concerning said vacation upon the records, and that a copy thereof will be certified to the Register of Deeds, Lincoln County, Kansas.


