On call compensation/Week days	\$ 1.50 per hour
On call compensation/Week ends	\$ 2.00 per hour
(Weekend – 6pm., Friday to 6a.m. Monday)	
On call compensation Holidays	\$ 3.00 per hour
(Holiday – 6 p.m. Holiday eve to 6 a.m. next day)	

Compensation for full time Lincoln County Ambulance Service personnel, working a scheduled shift, shall be the approved hourly rate of pay, no on-call compensation or run time compensation. Full time personnel working a volunteer shift shall receive on-call compensation and approved hourly rate for ambulance runs.
