

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-20

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE POSTING OF TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICES ON PORTIONS OF LINCOLN COUNTY ROADS LOCATED IN FRANKLIN AND MADISON TOWNSHIPS, LINCOLN COUNTY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Kansas have determined that it is necessary to erect and maintain traffic control devices pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2001 *et seq.*

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County Kansas, to erect and maintain the following traffic-control devices pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2001 *et seq.*:


- Yield sign on N 240th Rd at the intersection of E Colt Dr
- Yield sign on N 250th Rd at the intersection of E Colt Dr
- Yield signs on N 260th Rd at the intersection of E Colt Dr
- Yield signs on N 270th Rd at the intersection of E Colt Dr
- Yield signs on N 280th Rd at the intersection of E Colt Dr

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all traffic control devices erected and maintained by the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Kansas, shall remain in force and effect as of the date installed. No further action on the part of the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Kansas, shall be required to enforce the traffic control devices erected and maintained pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2001 *et seq.*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that violation of Resolution 2007-20 shall be punishable in accordance with the traffic laws of the State of Kansas and Lincoln County, and, any person convicted of such violation shall be punished as provided for by law.
