

WHEREAS, the city of Barnard, Kansas (and other parties) have caused to be constructed a billboard sign which provides directional information to the City of Barnard; and

WHEREAS, the City of Barnard has gained permission from property owner to erect and locate said sign at K-14 and K-284 junction, which is outside the territorial or zoning jurisdiction of the City of Barnard; and

WHEREAS, said sign will conform to the definition of an "official sign" if ownership of the sign is accepted by the Board of Commissioners of Lincoln County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Barnard agrees to comply with all laws and regulations of Lincoln County and the State of Kansas concerning billboard signs and the City further agrees to properly maintain said sign and not allow it to fall into disrepair; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Lincoln County agrees to accept ownership of said sign provided that the City of Barnard will comply with the laws, rules and regulations of Lincoln County and the State of Kansas and, further provided that the City of Barnard maintains and repairs such sign.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LINCOLN COUNTY, KANSAS that the ownership of the above mentioned sign is hereby accepted and the sign shall become the property of Lincoln County pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Department of Transportation of the State of Kansas for its approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the City of Barnard fail to comply with the terms and conditions agreed to above then the Board of County Commissioners will return ownership of the sign to the City of Barnard, which body will be responsible for the removal of the sign or such other proceedings as are necessary.
