

**RESOLUTION NO. 2003-09**

**RESOLUTION DECLARING MINIMUM MAINTENANCE ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Kansas, is authorized by and pursuant to K.S.A. 68-5,102 and K.S.A. 19-101 et seq., to make such orders concerning property belonging to the County as they deem necessary, and to declare certain County roads as minimum maintenance roads.

AND, WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Kansas, deem it to be in the public's best interests, both as a safety measure and for economic reasons, to determine the road more specifically described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, to be declared a "minimum maintenance road" pursuant to K.S.A. 68-5,102.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with K.S.A. 68-5,102(c), a hearing will be held in the Meeting Room of the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Kansas, of the Courthouse Building, 216 E. Lincoln, Lincoln, Kansas, on the 31st day of March, 2003, at 10:00 o'clock a.m. Any person wishing to appear at such hearing and give evidence or testimony thereon, may do so. At the conclusion of such hearing, the Board shall determine what road or parts of roads described in such resolution are to be declared minimum maintenance roads.

Persons or entities unable to attend said public hearing may express themselves in written correspondence delivered to the Clerk of Lincoln County, Kansas, 216 E. Lincoln, Lincoln, Kansas, 67455, prior to March 28, 2003.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution shall be effective upon publication in The Lincoln Sentinel-Republican for one(1) consecutive week beginning March 19, 2003.

A COUNTY ROAD  
LOCATED IN SECTION 35, TWSP 13 S, RG 7 W OF THE 6TH P.M.  
LINCOLN COUNTY, KANSAS.

Extending thirty feet (30') to each side of that portion of the south boundary of Section  
35, Township 13 South, Range 7 West of the 6th P.M., Lincoln County,  
Kansas, west of the Interstate 70 right-of-way.
