

RESOLUTION 2004-21

WASTE TIRE DISPOSAL FEE

A resolution establishing the fees to dispose waste tires at the Lincoln County Landfill/Transfer Station, and further rescinding Resolution 94-05 and Resolution 92-01

WHEREAS, Kansas law prohibits burying of waste tires in the county sanitary landfill and alternative means of disposal has been developed, and

WHEREAS, Several private firms are engaged in collecting and cutting of waste tires for permitted disposal, and


WHEREAS, There is a charge to the county for subsequent legal disposal of waste tires which should not be borne by the taxpayer,

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that effective December 20, 2004 the Lincoln County Landfill/Transfer Station will charge waste tire disposal fees to persons or firms that deliver or ship waste tires to the county landfill/transfer station. The fee charged will be as follows:

| Light Truck and Truck Tires | 4.00 |
| Heavy Truck Tires up to 18.4 x 42 | 13.00 |
| Small Tractor Tires up to 23.1 x 30 | 25.00 |
| Large Tractor and Loader Tires | 50.00 |

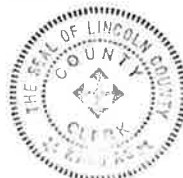
