The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met in a special session at the Sylvan Grove American Legion Hall on Thursday, February 24, 2022. Chairman Dennis Ray called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with Vice-Chairman Darrell Oetting and Member Randy Lohmann present. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance as recording secretary.

Purpose: to gather community input on spending the \$575,334 of federal funding received from the American Rescue Plan Act.
