Solid Waste does not included hazardous waste as defined by subsection (f) contained gaseous waste other discarded materials including, but not limited to, solid, semi-solid sludges, liquid WHEREAS, K.S.A. 65-3402 establishes the definition of "Solid Waste" as garbage, refuse, and 65-3430, and amendments thereto, recyclables or the waste of domestic animals as materials resulting from industrial, commercial,

PRUSUANT to K.S.A. 65-3410, the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Kansas, did resolve to collect solid waste disposal fees on occupied residences located within the boundaries of Lincoln County, Kansas, commencing January 1, 1993. A residential unit shall be defined as a dwelling unit such as a home, mobile home or multifamily dwelling of four or fewer units where one electric meter serves all units.

the Cities of Barnard, Beverly, Lincoln Center and Sylvan Grove shall be billed at the rate of household. All Lincoln County, Kansas, occupied residence collected on a city utility billing in each occupied residence located within Lincoln County, Kansas, commencing January 1, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, to establish the 2004 solid waste disposal fee to be charged to \$5.00 per resident per month with all years thereafter until changed by resolution or law, at \$60.00 per 2004,

year, commencing January 1, 2004 and continuing with all years thereafter until changed by resolution or law, fee to be billed on the 2003 ad valorem tax year statement and mailed to the residential units located within Lincoln County, Kansas, at the rate of \$60.00 per household per property owner to whom tax statements are mailed in accordance with K.S.A. FURTHUR RESOLVED, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-3410, to bill all other occupied 79-2001, and

waste generated or by the actual weight recorded at the Lincoln County Solid Waste Transfer or industrial activity located within Lincoln County, Kansas, based upon an estimate of solid Kansas, did resolve to collect solid waste disposal fees on each operating business, commercial Station, and PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 65-3410 the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County,

commencing January 1, 2004 and continuing with all years thereafter until changed by resolution or law, to be charged to each operating business, commercial or industrial activity located within BE IT FURTHUR RESOLVED, to establish a four cent per pound 2004 solid waste disposal fee Lincoln County, Kansas, and

per year to be charged to each operating business, commercial or industrial activity located within Lincoln County, Kansas, commencing January 1, 2004 and continuing with all years thereafter until changed by resolution or law, and BE IT FURTHUR RESOLVED to establish a minimum 2004 solid waste disposal fee of \$60.00

BE IT FURTHUR RESOLVED, to collect a 1 ½% penalty on all operating businesses, commercial or industrial activity accounts not received within thirty days of billing date.
