

FINAL RESOLUTION AND ORDER
RESOLUTION NO. 2021V-02

Now on this 1st day of March, 2021, at a duly constituted and regular meeting of the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, Lincoln County, Kansas, all members of said board being present, the matter of the vacation of a certain road comes on for final hearing and order before said board.

After due consideration, and after being duly advised in the premises, the board finds, that on the 16th day of February, 2021, the said board did unanimously make a preliminary resolution, 2021R-02, proposing to vacate a certain road located in Beaver Township, as in their judgement said road is not a public utility by reason of neglect, nonuse, or inconvenience or from other cause or causes said road has become practically impassable and the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said road or put the same in condition for public travel; said road is described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter (NE1/4 NE1/4) also being the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter (SE1/4 NE1/4) all being in Section Thirty (30), Township Eleven (11), Range Seven (7) thence West 540 feet, also known as E Nemaha Ln. Right away is forty (40) ft.

and that said preliminary resolution is herewith adopted and made a part of this order by reference.

The board further finds that due and legal notice of said proposed vacation has been given by publication as required by law, and the proof thereof has been duly filed with the County Clerk.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ALL MEMBERS VOTING IN THE AFFIRMATIVE: That the above described roads, and every part hereof, should be vacated, and is hereby vacated, as above described, and that the County Clerk enter the proceedings concerning said vacation upon the records, and that a copy thereof will be certified to the Register of Deeds, Lincoln County, Kansas.




