RESOLUTION NO. 2005-18

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE POSTING OF SPEED LIMIT SIGNS ON PORTIONS OF A LINCOLN COUNTY ROAD LOCATED IN PLEASANT AND HIGHLAND TOWNSHIPS, LINCOLN COUNTY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Kansas have determined that it is necessary to erect and maintain traffic control devices pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2001 *et seq*.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County Kansas, to establish a maximum speed limit pursuant to K.S.A. 8-1558 at fifty-five (55) miles per hour and to erect and maintain traffic control devices on that portion of the County blacktop road, known as N 60th Rd, that begins at the intersection in which Hwy 181 veers West. The County road continues from the aforesaid intersection South to the Lincoln County line, such road is located in Pleasant and Highland Townships.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all traffic control devices erected and maintained by the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Kansas, shall remain in force and effect as of the date installed. No further action on the part of the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Kansas, shall be required to enforce the traffic control devices erected and maintained pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2001 et seq.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that violation of Resolution 2005-18 shall be punishable in accordance with the traffic laws of the State of Kansas and Lincoln County, and, any person convicted of such violation shall be punished as provided for by law.
