

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

November 16, 2015

- Call to Order: The regular meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners was held in the commission meeting room of the courthouse Monday, November 16, 2015. Chairman Gerald Huehl called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. with Member Terry Finch present. Vice-Chairman Al Joe Wallace was absent. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance.
- Visitors: Others present for portions of the meeting: Mike Weigel, Karlton Place, Michel O'Hare, and Robert Howe.
- Member Arrives: Vice-Chairman Al Joe Wallace arrived at 8:25 a.m.
- Law Enforcement: Sheriff Mike Weigel discussed installing GPS navigation systems into the patrol vehicles, future vehicle considerations and related that the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center (KLETC) was at a recent meeting and indicated that the cost to train an officer for the 14 week session is \$14,000.
- Agreement Amendment Approved: Karlton Place, Kansas Department of Transportation, presented an amended agreement for the board's approval. Al Joe Wallace moved to enter into an amended agreement authorizing reimbursement to the County to patch and chip seal E Milo Dr in an amount not to exceed \$23,473.71, seconded by Terry Finch. Motion carried.
- Highway Department: Director of Public Work Michel O'Hare with Road and Bridge Supervisor Robert Howe reported on highway department projects and equipment.
- Minutes Approved: Terry Finch moved to approve and adopt the minutes of the November 9, 2015 regular meeting as presented, seconded by Al Joe Wallace. Motion carried.
