

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

May 28, 2010

- Call to Order: The regular meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners was held in the commission meeting room of the courthouse Friday, May 28, 2010. Chairman Al Joe Wallace called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. with Vice-Chairman Terry Finch and Member Steve Errebo present. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance.
- Visitors: Others present for portions of the meeting: Wendy Gronau.
- Ambulance Service: Ambulance Service Director Wendy Gronau reported that Rod Rees has passed his paramedic certification test and that one first responder student has passed all testing necessary for certification. Gronau requested approval to purchase radios for new ambulance service attendants. The board approved the request.
- Payroll & Accounts Payable Approved: Steve Errebo moved to approve May gross payroll in the amount of \$156,507.07 and May accounts payable warrants in the amount of \$454,623.57, seconded by Terry Finch. Motion carried.
- WEB Fund Board Applications: The board discussed the deadline for applicants to apply to serve on the Windpower Economic Benefit (WEB) fund board. Clerk Harlow related that she had received four applications to date, and that one of the applicants related that they did not feel that there was enough advertisement for the board positions. After discussion, the board determined that they would like to extend the date to accept applications to 4:30 p.m. June 25.
