Called to Order: The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met in a special session in the courthouse commission meeting room on Tuesday, January 25, 2022. Chairman Dennis Ray called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. with Vice-Chairman Darrell Oetting and Member Randy Lohmann present. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance as recording secretary.

Health Department: Health Nurse/Administrator Ladonna Reinert requested that the board declare a Public Health Emergency so that the Hospital and the Health Department can obtain supplies through the State. Dennis Ray moved to approve Resolution 2022-09, COVID 19 Public Health Emergency Resolution, in effect for 60 days, seconded by Randy Lohmann. Motion carried.
