

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

May 28, 2021

- Call to Order: The Lincoln County Board of Commissioner met in the courthouse commission meeting room Friday, May 28, 2021. Chairman Randy Lohmann called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. with Vice-Chairman Dennis Ray and Member Darrell Oetting present. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance as recording secretary.
- Visitors: Others present for portions of the meeting: Leann Bishop, Dustin Florence, and Lucas Sanders.
- Payroll Approved: Dennis Ray moved to approve May's payroll in the amount of \$199,679.55, seconded by Randy Lohmann. Motion carried.
- Accounts Payable Approved: Dennis Ray moved to approve May's accounts payable in the amount of \$611,651.18, seconded by Darrell Oetting. Motion carried.
- Employment Status Change: Dennis Ray moved to change Mr. Caleb Holeman's employment status from Interim Director of Highway Department to Office Manager, at the current pay, to be reevaluated at two weeks, seconded by Darrell Oetting. Motion carried.
- Miscellaneous: Commissioner Ray related that Mary Ann Stertz has agreed to be the future contact person for the courthouse rehabilitation project. Commissioner Lohmann decided to participate in the flood plain mapping project. Commissioner Ray notified the board that he had been contacted by the City of Lincoln regarding the placement of manure on the N 5<sup>th</sup> St property. Commissioner Ray requested that Commissioner Oetting contact Steve McReynolds to remove all materials that he placed on the lot. He also suggested that the board ask the highway department to haul some dirt to the location.
- County Treasurer: County Treasurer Leann Bishop presented the Treasurer's office 2022 budget request.
- Law Enforcement: Sheriff Dustin Florence and Undersheriff Lucas Sanders presented the 2022 budget requests for the Sheriff's Department, Communications, and Special Vehicle fund.
- WEB Funds: The board discussed whether it was feasible to utilize the Windpower Economic Benefit Fund for the 2022 budget year, potentially reducing the burden on taxpayers.
