

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

March 1, 2022

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met in special session at the Colorado Township Hall in Beverly on Tuesday, March 1, 2022. Chairman Dennis Ray called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with Vice-Chairman Darrell Oetting and Member Randy Lohmann present. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was present as recording secretary.

Purpose: to gather community input on spending the \$575,334 of federal funding received from the American Rescue Plan Act.

Attendees identified the following needs: City of Beverly new water well; City of Beverly playground equipment and landscaping at the City Park; City of Beverly improvements to Main St; and Twin Valley Telephone Company can expand broadband internet service with assistance in determining needs, funding, and partnership with third parties.

Ambulance Service Director Brandon Cochran provided attendees with the proposal and information previously presented for the Lincoln County Ambulance Service.

Previously submitted proposals were announced, including the City of Barnard lift station, Lincoln County Sheriff's Department reporting/ticketing program and hardware, broadband internet, Post Rock Rural Water District automatic water meter readers, USD 299 gymnasium HVAC upgrade, and Lincoln Track Committee new track at the Jim Mettner field.
