

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

September 27, 2010

- Call to Order: The regular meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners was held in the commission meeting room of the courthouse Monday, September 27, 2010. Chairman Al Joe Wallace called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. with Vice-Chairman Terry Finch and Member Steve Errebo present. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance.
- Visitors: Others present for portions of the meeting: Norman Mannel, Larry Meitler, Michel O'Hare, Jennifer O'Hare and Christen Robinson.
- Proclamation: Terry Finch moved to proclaim the month of October 2010 as Down Syndrome Awareness Month, encouraging all of Lincoln County to work together to promote awareness of Down Syndrome and to celebrate the accomplishments of individuals and their families, seconded by Steve Errebo. Motion carried.
- Highway Department: Road Supervisor Larry Meitler with Assistant Road Supervisor Michel O'Hare reported on highway department projects.
- County Owned Property Sold: County Attorney Jennifer O'Hare presented a quit claim deed for the board to review and approve. Steve Errebo moved to allow the chairman to sign a quit claim deed selling the following property to Douglas L. Lebien: a tract of land beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 6, Township 12 South, Range 7 West, thence North a distance of seventy feet, thence East a distance of one hundred twenty-nine feet, thence South a distance of Seventy feet, thence West a distance of one hundred twenty-nine feet to the point of beginning, seconded by Terry Finch. Motion carried.
- Nursing Home: Nursing Home Administrator Christen Robinson reported on nursing home activities; identified inventory that should be owned by Lincoln Park Manor and the County; and Medicare changes that will affect future payments to the facility.
- Minutes Approved: Terry Finch moved to approve and adopt the minutes of the September 20, 2010 regular meeting and September 20, 2010 special meeting as presented, seconded by Steve Errebo. Motion carried.
