

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

September 6, 2011

- Call to Order: The regular meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners was held in the commission meeting room of the courthouse Tuesday, September 6, 2011. Chairman Terry Finch called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. with Vice-Chairman Steve Errebo and Member Al Joe Wallace present. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance.
- Visitors: Others present for portions of the meeting: Wendy Gronau, Michel O’Hare and Larry Meitler.
- Ambulance Service: Ambulance Service Director Wendy Gronau reported that there are nine students taking the EMT class and all signed contracts to qualify for Education Incentive Grant funds. Gronau provided an agreement for the board’s approval. Steve Errebo moved to allow the chairman to sign the Education Incentive Grant Program Memorandum of Agreement Service Form as presented, seconded by Al Joe Wallace. Motion carried.
