

Transportation of Children

Children are allowed to utilize the Transportation Bus Service and are expected to follow all rules. An appropriate child passenger safety restraining system will be provided and used for all children under eight (8) years and who weigh less than 80 pounds or is less than 4 feet 9 inches in height. All other children will be required to use a safety belt as required by law.

- Children under the age of ten (10) years must ride with an adult. Children in this category will not be required to pay a fare.
- Children ten (10) years or older may ride without an adult, with a signed consent form. Children in this category will be required to pay the same fare as all other riders.

Consent Form:

A parent or guardian must complete and submit the Consent Form before transport is scheduled. A new Consent Form will be required to be completed for each day the child utilizes the service. The Consent Form requires the following information: two (2) emergency contact names and phone numbers, a destination address, and the name of an adult who will meet the child.

The driver will make sure the assigned adult meets the child at the drop-off location. Depending on arrangements the driver may return the child to point-of-pickup or leave at the drop-off location.
