

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

November 6, 2013

- Call to Order: A special meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners was held Wednesday, November 6, 2013 in the basement meeting room of the courthouse. Chairman Al Joe Wallace called the meeting to order at 10:40 a.m. with Vice-Chairman Terry Finch and Member Gerald Huehl present.
- Visitors: Others present for portions of the meeting: Jyll Phillips, Sheriff Mike Weigel, Barb Rathbun, Judge Kim Cudney, County Attorney Jennifer O'Hare and Judge Brian Grace.
- Purpose: The board met with Judge Kim Cudney, Judge Brian Grace, County Attorney Jennifer O'Hare and Sheriff Mike Weigel to discuss the impact of HB 2052, and implementation of security to ensure the safety of court staff. District Judge Kim Cudney related that she will require that safety measures be implemented while she is in court, by banning all weapons from being carried into the courtroom by any individual. Cudney defined weapons as all guns including concealed carried weapons and knives. The group acknowledged that in order to comply with Judge Cudney's concerns that the county will be required to have an officer in court and that each individual will need to either be searched or scanned by a metal detector. Plans will be prepared to adequately provide this service.
