RESOLUTION 2010-11

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Lincoln, Kansas, by the powers vested in it by K.S.A. 1-101(a) may perform powers of local legislation, and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 21-3105 and 21-4009 through 21-4014 prohibits smoking in a public place except in designated smoking areas, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissions of Lincoln County, Kansas, that effective July 1, 2010, the following is enacted and shall be in force:

All Lincoln County buildings, vehicles, and equipment including all enclosed areas and places of employment shall hereby be designated to be smoke and tobacco free. Such prohibition shall include any access point within a ten foot radius outside any doorway, open window or air intake leading into any building, vehicle, equipment and enclosed area pursuant to K.S.A. 21-4010(d) and amendments thereto. Any person found guilty of smoking or using tobacco in violation with this resolution shall be fined as set forth in K.S.A. 21-4012.
