an That road beginning 1,320 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 26, Township 10 South, Range 8 West, thence running South one mile to the South line of Section 26, said right-of-way being fifty feet.

The board arms 1 diparts and that said preliminary resolution is herewith adopted and made a part of this order by reference.

The board further finds that due and legal notice of said proposed vacation has been given by publication as required by law, and the proof thereof has been duly filed with the County Clerk.

That the above described road, and every part hereof, should be vacated, and it is hereby vacated, as above described, and that the County Clerk enter the proceedings concerning said vacation upon the records, and that a copy thereof will be certified to the Register of Deeds, Lincoln County, Kansas.
