WHEREAS said Board has reviewed K.S.A. 12-16,119 which states that any person convicted or diverted, or adjudicated or diverted under a preadjudication program, pursuant to K.S.A. 22-2906 et seq., 38-1635 et seq., or 12-4414 et seq., and amendments thereto, of a misdemeanor or felony contained in chapters 8, 21, 41, or 65 of the Kansas Statute Annotated, and amendments thereto, where fingerprints are required pursuant to K.S.A. 21-2501, and amendments thereto, the Board of County Commissioners may vote to adopt a separate court cost as a booking or processing fee for each complaint; and

to M.S./WHEREAS said Board votes to establish a booking or processing fee of \$25.00 pursuant to K.S.A. 12-16,119; and

body WHEREAS disbursements of these fees shall be to the general fund of the governing body responsible for the funding of the sheriff, police department or countywide law enforcement agency that obtain the fingerprints.
