We as a board are dedicated to the enhancement of our community through increased population and improvement of County Infrastructure and other means vested within the powers of the Board; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LINCOLN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, this 28th day of September, 2020, to rescind Resolution 2000-12, dated March 20th, 2000, providing county road improvement based on merit of request, See Exhibit "A" Attached, and;

FURTHER RESOLVE that the Board of County Commissioners will approve County Road Improvements to encourage economic development of rural areas of Lincoln County based on the following guidelines.

- The material used for the Road Improvement will come from the County Owned/Leased Gravel/Sand Pits
- The County will bear all expenses for the first ½ mile of Road Improvement. (Equipment, Material, Labor, etc.)
- The party requesting the Road Improvement will be responsible for all costs (Equipment, Material, Labor, etc.) after the first ½ mile.
- The Road Improvement will require a minimum Right of Way (ROW) of 60 (sixty) feet. If the
 road does not have sufficient ROW, the land will need to be donated to or acquired by Lincoln
 County with the requesting party solely responsible for all acquisition costs (Land Purchase,
 Survey, etc)
- The requesting party will be responsible to prepay the total estimated amount of the above points before any Road Improvement is started.
