The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met in a special session at the Barnard Lions Club Community Building on Tuesday, February 22, 2022. Chairman Dennis Ray called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with Vice-Chairman Darrell Oetting present and Member Randy Lohmann absent. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance as recording secretary.

Purpose: to gather community input on spending the \$575,334 of federal funding received from the American Rescue Plan Act.

Attendees identified the following needs: City of Barnard lift station including mechanical equipment, building, and generator; Lincoln Sheriff's Department patrol unit reporting and ticketing program with hardware for each vehicle; Lincoln County Ambulance Service three Stryker Mechanical CPR units, defibrillator/monitor, three Stryker Auto Load cot systems with two cots and the revamp of one cot, and a new ambulance; and broadband internet improvements.

Previously submitted proposals were announced, including Post Rock Rural Water District automatic water meter readers and USD 299 gymnasium HVAC upgrade.
