attendance.

Law Enforcement: Sheriff Russ Black presented the amended law enforcement budget with the City of

Contract Approved: Steve Errebo moved to allow the chairman to sign the amended law enforcement

agreement between the City of Lincoln Center and Lincoln County granting a ten percent increase beginning January 1, 2011, seconded by Terry Finch. Motion carried.

Highway Department: Road Supervisor Larry Meitler with Assistant Road Supervisor Michel O'Hare reported

on highway department projects. Meitler presented a gravel agreement for the board's approval. Terry Finch moved to enter into a three year gravel removal/purchase agreement with the Edward Hlad Trust and Mildred L Hlad Trust, expiring August 31, 2013, seconded by Steve Errebo. Motion carried. Road Supervisors provided information on an incident to which a resident has removed a portion of the windrow along a county road in Section 10, Marion Township. O'Hare provided cost estimates received from John Cashatt to repair four sections of N 120<sup>th</sup> Rd totaling \$358,400.00.

The board approved applying for CDBG grant funds for the project.

Hospital:

Hospital Board of Trustees Chairman Stanley Crawford with Hospital Administrator Greg McNeil and County Attorney Jennifer O'Hare were in attendance for a telephone conference with the hospital's auditor regarding one of the covenants in the lease agreement with the Public Building Commission, that requires the hospital to complete additional requirements including obtaining a release from the county if the hospital enters into debt causing the debt service ratio to exceed the ratio agreed to in the

covenant. County Attorney O'Hare will research the matter.

Central Kansas Mental Steve Errebo moved to approve the annual contract with Central Kansas Mental Health Health Contract: Center, for fiscal year 2010, in the amount of \$12,591.00, seconded by Terry Finch.
