## **COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS**

October 22, 2012

Call to Order: The regular meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners was held in the

commission meeting room of the courthouse Monday, October 22, 2012. Chairman Steve Errebo called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. with Vice-Chairman Al Joe Wallace and Member Terry Finch present. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in

attendance.

Landfill/Transfer

Station:

Kerry Jackson inquired about returning to Saturday winter hours. After discussion the board approved allowing the Landfill/Transfer Station to return to Saturday

Winter hours, 9 a.m. - 1 p.m., beginning November 10.

Health Department: Health Nurse/Administrator Ladonna Reinert discussed a grant opportunity available

and requested that the commission submit a letter of support as the Lincoln County

Board of Health.

Post Rock Jennifer O'Hare and Ladonna Reinert as members of the Post Rock Community

Community Foundation related that there is an individual who would be willing to meet with Commissioners to allow commissioner members to ask questions about advantages

of investing and donating funds to foundations like the Post Rock Community

Foundation.

Highway Department: Road Supervisor Larry Meitler with Assistant Road Supervisor Michel O'Hare

reported on highway department projects. O'Hare provided gravel a yearly gravel report, discussed equipment, and expressed concern over current personnel

shortages.

Public Hearing: The chairman convened the scheduled public hearing concerning delinquent business

solid waste disposal fees at 10:00 a.m. to hear comments concerning the addition of special assessments for delinquent business solid waste fees to several properties with Steve Ryan and Randy Schroeder present. Steve Ryan requested that the board not access the property owner as The Pit Stop, the business incurring the bill, rented the facility from the property owner. The board will consider the request. Randy Shroeder, M & G Designs, related that disposal fees had not been paid as the business does not believe that estimated tonnage is accurate after discussion it was determined that one of the businesses dumpsters is being utilized by another business. After discussion the board agreed to retroactively adjust the tonnage to the business minimum of 150 pounds per month. The chairman closed the public hearing

and reconvened the meeting to regular session at 10:25 a.m.

Double Arch Bridge

Project:

Duane Vonada provided information on the project to install wing walls to the historic double arch bridge. Vonada inquired if the county had a piling driver and if

so, would the county be willing to complete that part of the project. The board will visit with the highway department to determine if we have the necessary equipment.

Radio Rebanding: Al Joe Wallace moved to contract with Ka-Comm to complete rebanding

county departments and fire districts, seconded by Terry Finch. Motion carried.

Solid Waste Removal Al Joe Wallace moved to enter into agreements with the following cities providing for Solid Waste Collection and Disposal within the city limits: Barnard, Beverly,

Lincoln Center and Sylvan Grove, seconded by Terry Finch. Motion carried.
