Commission Discussion:

Commissioner Lohmann related that two interviews were conducted for the Human Resource Officer position. After discussion, the board authorized Clerk Harlow to make an offer to the qualified candidate. Commissioner Gabelmann discussed the following: utilizing KCAMP's sample handbook, with minor changes that correspond with the county's specific practices; additional lighting in the County Attorney's Office and the potential for the County Attorney to retain additional counsel to assist with the current work and case load; courthouse building hours should be 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Discussion ensued on the following subjects: working hours for employees; imbalance of additional responsibilities on the County Clerk's office versus statutory duties; commission taking over the agenda scheduling and preparation; overtime for staff; budget, taxation, how services are funded, and the tax lid; purchasing policy for courthouse maintenance; flex scheduling for the janitor/maintenance; and use of the courthouse facility by organizations and businesses. John Paul Ellis, courthouse janitor/maintenance requested a \$500 limit for equipment needs without prior approval.
