## COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

September 26, 2011

Call to Order: The regular meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners was held in the

commission meeting room of the courthouse Monday, September 26, 2011. Chairman Terry Finch called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. with Vice-Chairman Steve Errebo and Member Al Joe Wallace present. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance.

Visitors: Others present for portions of the meeting: Jennifer O'Hare, Larry Sharp, Michel

O'Hare and Stan Labertew.

County Attorney: County Attorney Jennifer O'Hare discussed county legal matters.

KCAMP: Larry Sharp, KCAMP Member Services Representative, explained that KCAMP, the

County's insurance provider, required specific insured real property to be appraised to determine replacement cost. Sharp presented and reviewed the property appraisal report

for Lincoln County.

Highway Department: Assistant Road Supervisor Michel O'Hare discussed highway department projects.

O'Hare reported that Hi-Plains Sand Inc used the wrong type of rock to complete the

chip and seal project and provided possible solutions to resolve the problem.

Public Hearing: The chairman convened the scheduled public hearing concerning delinquent business
