Community Cleanup Day:	James Gabelmann discussed the community cleanup day being held Saturday, September 14, 2013 and requested that the construction/demolition fees be waived for properties that will be cleared that day. Chairman Wallace stated that construction/demolition fees will not be waived however the fee to the landowner would likely only be \$15 per ton, as the City was willing to contribute \$10 per ton if the county would match.
