COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

March 3, 2022

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met in special session at the Finch Theatre in Lincoln on Thursday, March 3, 2022. Chairman Dennis Ray called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with Vice-Chairman Darrell Oetting and Member Randy Lohmann present. County Clerk Dawn Harlow was in attendance as recording secretary.

Purpose: to gather community input on spending the \$575,334 of federal funding received from the American Rescue Plan Act.

Visitors: Lloyd Gier, Becky Cheney, Debora Zachgo, Brandon Cochran, John Baetz, Shiloh Florence, and Bryce Wheeler.

Attendees identified the following needs: Lincoln Track Committee a new track at the Jim Mettner field; and Economic Development still a need for childcare facilities.

Ambulance Service Director Brandon Cochran provided attendees with the proposal and information previously presented for the Lincoln County Ambulance Service.

Previously submitted proposals were announced, including the City of Barnard lift station, Lincoln County Sheriff's Department reporting/ticketing program and hardware, broadband internet, Post Rock Rural Water District automatic water meter readers, USD 299 gymnasium HVAC upgrade, Lincoln Track Committee new track at the Jim Mettner field, City of Beverly new water well, park equipment/landscaping and street improvements, and Twin Valley Telephone Company assistance with expanding broadband internet services.
